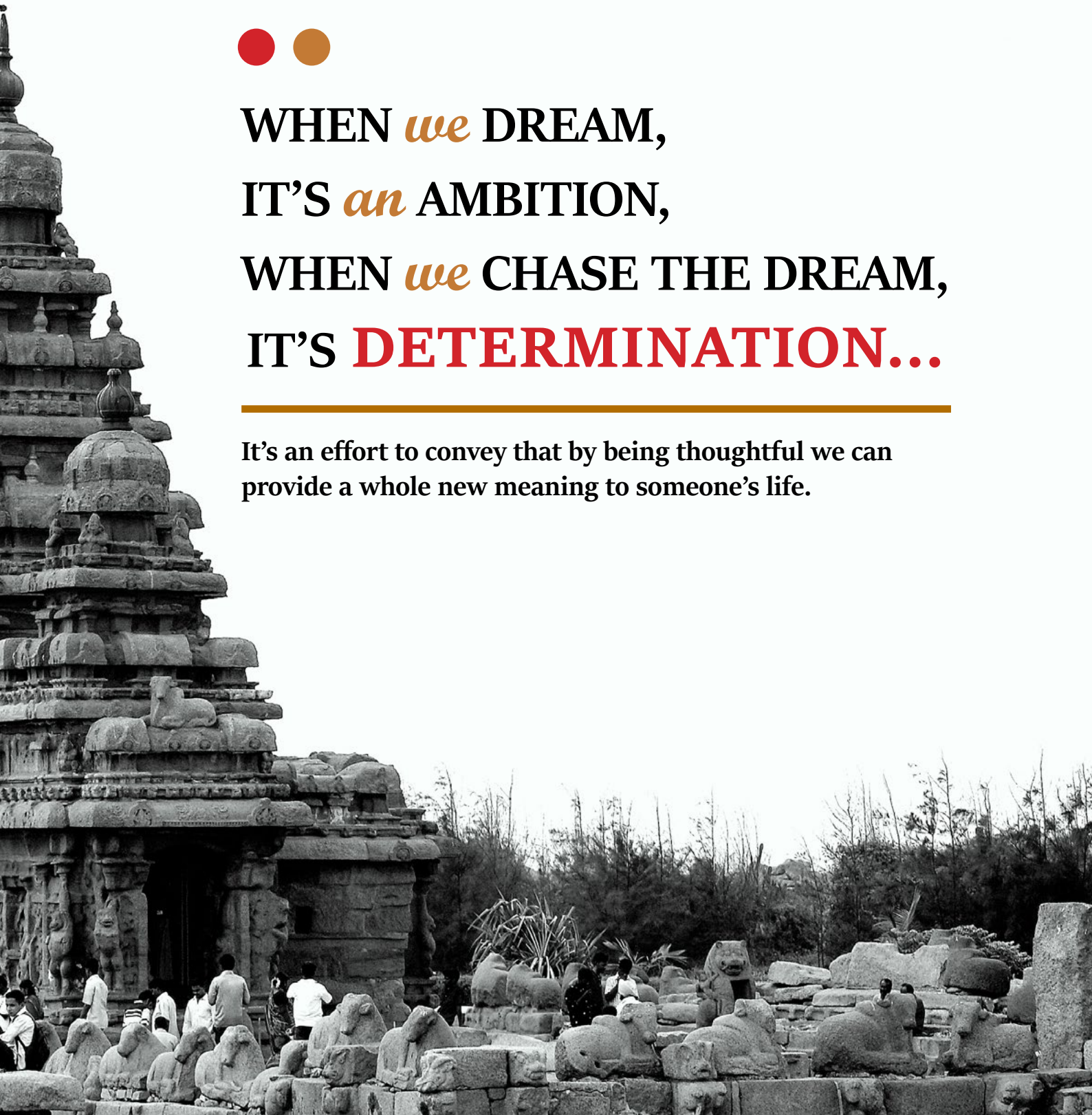

Culkey Foundation

The coronavirus outbreak is first and foremost a human tragedy, affecting hundreds of thousands of people. The nationwide lockdown imposed on March 25, 2020 to contain the COVID19 pandemic had left Hindu Priests in Karnataka in distress, as their earnings were affected.

At Culkey Foundation we realized that Archaka's & Purohit's do not have fixed income. Temples are shut and rituals that would happen at home have also stopped. Weddings and other Functions scheduled starting April, had been indefinitely postponed.

We also researched that there are totally 34,599 temples under the Muzrai Department, Government of Karnataka of which 175 temples are Class 'A' (annual revenue above Rs 25 Lakh), 163 Class 'B' temples (annual revenue between 5L - 25L) and the remaining 34,261 temples are Class 'C' (annual revenue is less than 5 Lakh). To service these temples there are 120,000 registered Archaka's. Majority of Class 'C' temple Archaka's are wholly dependent on this profession for their earnings are facing more problems. It is also learnt that there are private temples and archaka's who in all probability would be taken care by the trustees of such private temples.

To add to the problems, some Hindu rituals require the presence of two to three priests, along with the devotees, even if lockdown is lifted and mass gathering is not allowed how would they survive indefinitely? Thereby we at Culkey Foundation decided to help this segment of the society during COVID19 pandemic under the guidance of Prof S Sadagopan (Director - IIITB).

We had a overwhelming response and did collect donation in kind and money which is published in our website www.culkey.org

We were able to distribute the same to right people without any pilferage under the able leadership of Shri Dinesh Gundu Rao MLA and President of Akhila Karnataka Hindu Temple's Archaka, Agamika and Upadhivatar Federation and General Secretary Vidwan K S N Dikshit.

I would humbly like to thank all the donors our partners especially Vivvy Trading and volunteers for their support, without whom we couldn't have distributed over 2200+ ration kits and also give a part of the donated money to Akhila Karnataka Hindu Temple's Archaka, Agamika and Upadhivatar Federation who arranged over 500 kits for those districts where there were transportation challenges. With all the effort we could only reach about 2% of the needy archaka's during the pandemic and much more needs to be done to this segment.

As per the Archaka Okkuta's request we will be partnering with Akhila Karnataka Hindu Temple's Archaka, Agamika and Upadhivatar Federation to explore the possible ways to help them using technology.

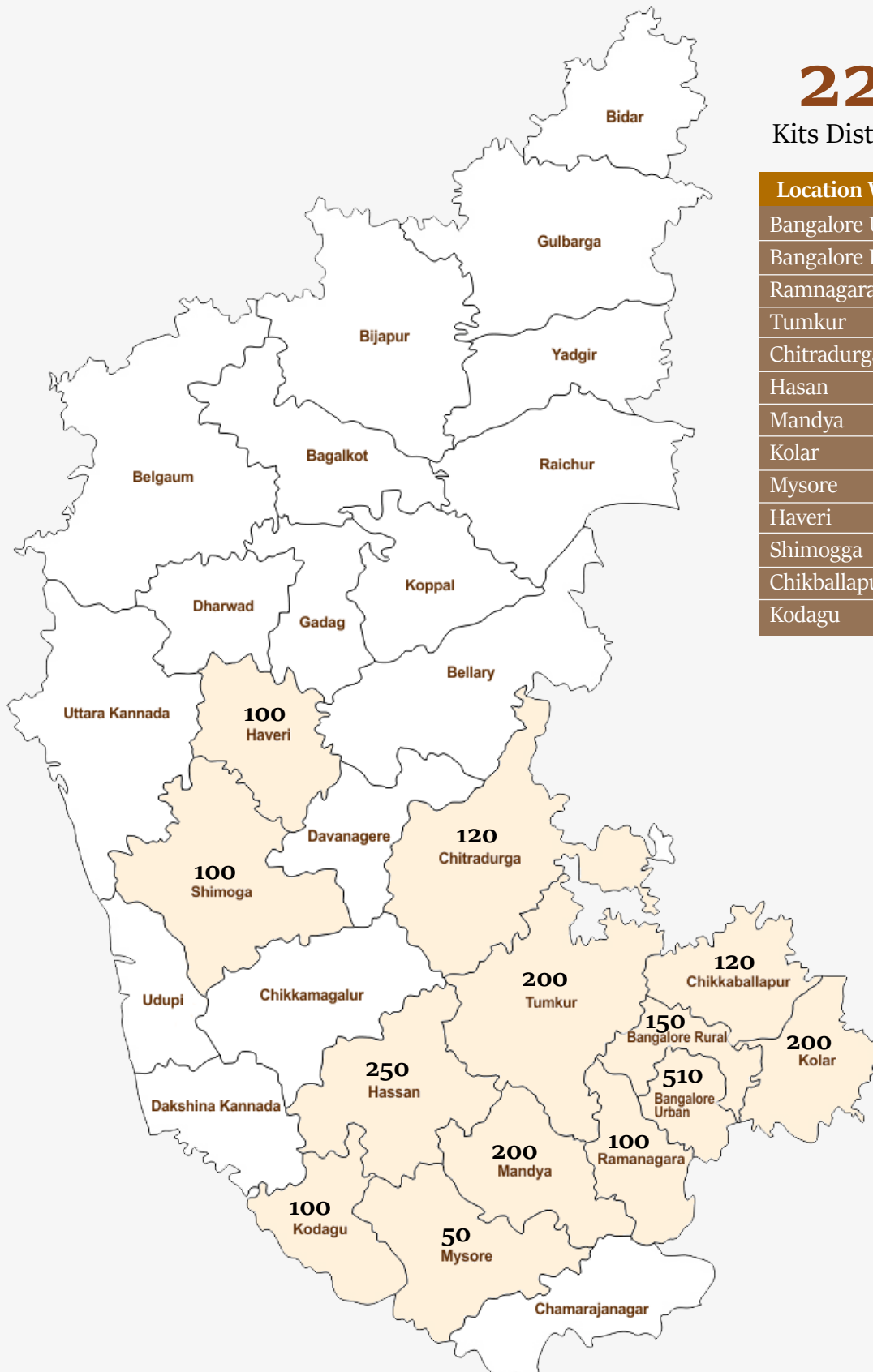

2.4 Relief work impact analysis

*Approx.

During our COVID19 relief work we associated with Akhila Karnataka Hindu Temple's Archaka, Agamika and Upadivanthara Federation and discovered more about temples, archaka's, purohit's, priests, cooks, etc.

We also learnt that there are Government run and privately run temples. Assuming that the private temples are mostly run by trusts and they would have taken care of such private temple, archaka's and purohit's we focused on the remaining temple Archaka's.

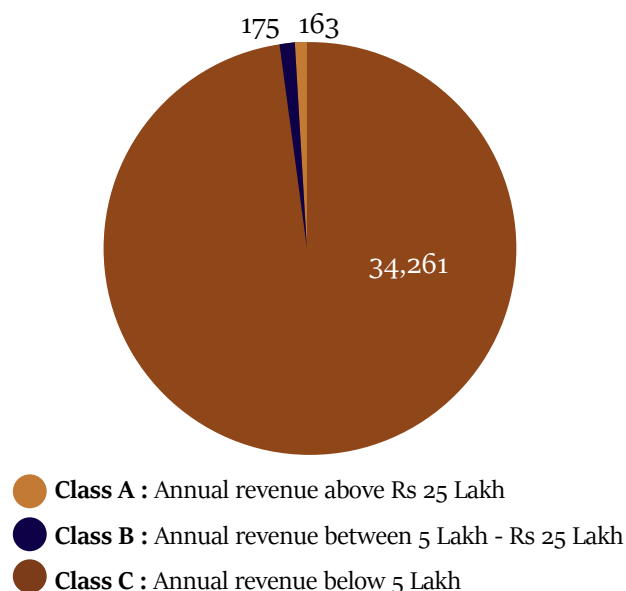
It was also learnt that most Class 'A' are classified as temples with revenue above 25 L Class 'B' temples as temples with revenue between 5L & 25L and Class 'C' Temples as Temples with Revenue less than Rs 5L, these Class C 'Archaka's get a honorarium (tastik) of Rs 48,000 per annum for the entire year in which they would have to get items for the temple idol Abhisheka, Prasada and maintain themselves too.

We mainly focused on providing aid to them. During the lockdown our major challenge was sourcing, warehousing, packaging, transportation, permissions and distribution keeping in mind the social distancing and regularly checking of temperature, etc, we successfully obtained all these permissions and did our relief work.

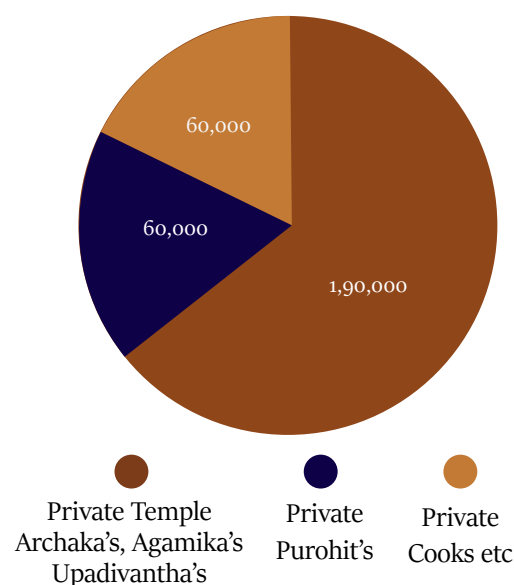
In 4 weeks we could reach out to 13 districts in Karnataka, Providing aid and ration kits to 2200+ families who are Archakas, Updivantha's and Agamika's of Class 'C' temples and we could reach out to about 2.2% of the total existing 1,00,000+ Class C Archaka's.

With lot more to be done to this section of the society we look forward to helping them further

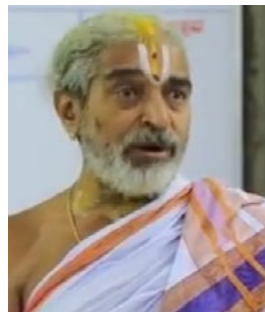

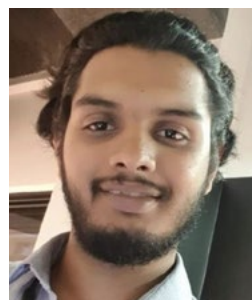

Our accomplishments :



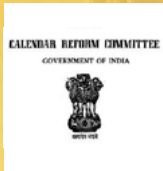
Bangalore Press - We built a Android App & the entire platform for digitizing the 100 year old Wall calendar, which is currently being tested
